The Eighth Annual Nature Art Showcase and Sale event will take place February 2-3, 2024 at the Barrow-Civic Theater located at 1223 Liberty Street in Franklin, PA. Art pieces representing the natural and recreational assets of northwestern PA, through diverse media, will be displayed and available for sale. Artists may enter one or two items. You have choice of \$10 registration fee, or signing up to volunteer a 2-hour shift to help staff the event, and must register item(s) by January 8, 2024. If your item sells, you will receive 85% of the price which you indicate in the registration materials. Registration is capped at 75 artists this year.
